

Detect-A-Leak Week

March 18-24, 2019

Please join us by spending time this week to make sure you don't have any leaks on your property. It's easy to do and in most cases homeowners can fix leaks without a major financial investment. Follow these easy steps to check for leaks:



- Turn off all your water faucets, pipes, and other water-using fixtures to make sure no water is running.
 - Locate your water meter, which should be in or near the sidewalk area fronting your building or home.
 - Open the meter cover and check to see if the dial is moving. If it is, you may have a leak! Have the leak repaired as soon as possible.
- Visually inspect faucets, pipes, and plumbing fixtures. For toilets, use dye tablets to check for leakage. **During Detect-A-Leak Week, FREE DYE TABLETS are available from the Board of Water Supply, City Mill, or at Satellite City Halls.**
- City Mill is also offering a discount on toilet flapper valves to customers who mention Detect-A-Leak Week at the time of purchase.
- Finally, examine your lawn for wet spots where grass seems greener. This could indicate a broken underground pipe.
