## CREATE YOUR OWN SELF-DRINKING PLANTERS

Sub-Irrigated Planter Workshop at the Halawa Xeriscape Garden

- WHAT: Create custom-made sub-irrigated planters that conserve water! A hands-on workshop offered by the Board of Water Supply (BWS) and Friends of Halawa Xeriscape Garden (FOHXG) will show you how to create an attractive sub-irrigated planter out of a recycled two-liter bottle.
- WHEN: Saturday, October 3, 2015 10:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.
- WHERE: Halawa Xeriscape Garden 99-1268 Iwaena Street Halawa Valley's Central Park Industrial Area
- **DETAILS:** This hands-on workshop involves recycling a two-liter drinking container to create a sub-irrigated (self-watering) planter. With an ounce of creativity, participants can fashion artful containers that are practical and simple to create. (Participants must bring their own two-liter container.)
