SAVE MONEY BY CONSERVING WATER



- 1. Have an adjustable nozzle that can be turned off when not in use. A hose, which is left running, can waste up to 500 gallons of water in a half hour.
- 2. Wash cars sensibly. Give the car a fast once-over with the hose, sponge dirt off a section at a time. Use a brief spray of water to rinse off the section, then do another section.
- Use the correct amount of cleaning agent added to a bucket of wash water. Too little will make cleaning difficult and will use more wash water. Too much will require an excessive amount of rinse water.
- 4. Wash cars in a shady area. This will prevent a rapid evaporation of water from the car's surface.
- 5. Check faucets for leaks. A small leak may waste 100 gallons of water per day.
- 6. Do not allow horseplay with the water.
