Halawa Xeriscape Garden Workshop

Gardening with beneficial micro-organisms promotes the growth of healthy plants which may require less watering and maintenance.

You’ll be taking home your very own concoction to use on your own plants and you’ll be the envy of your neighbors and friends when they see how you manage such beautiful and healthy plants effortlessly!
