LEARN TO MAKE A TI-LEAF LEI *Halawa Xeriscape Garden Workshop*

WHAT: Learn how to make a ti-leaf lei from the ti-leaves in your own garden. A hands-on workshop offered by the Board of Water Supply (BWS) and Friends of Halawa Xeriscape Garden (FOHXG) will show you how to make a ti leaf lei from this drought tolerant plant.
