BOARD OF WATER SUPPLY OFFERS TERRACOTTA MADNESS WORKSHOP

WHAT: The Board of Water Supply (BWS) and the Friends of Halawa Xeriscape Garden (FOHXG) are pleased to offer “**Terracotta Madness**” a new workshop that teaches participants about succulent propagation with the use of recycled pottery.

DETAILS: If you are thinking of throwing away any damaged or scrap pieces of broken terracotta pots, THINK AGAIN! The “**Terracotta Madness**” workshop provides an environmentally friendly way to bring new life to old and wrecked pots in an unusually functional and artistic way. Just bring your pots (new pots are also acceptable) to the workshop and the workshop instructors will show you how to reuse and recycle it for another round of planting.

At the workshop participants will also learn about succulent propagation, care, and placement, and will be provided with tips to decorate their recycled pot.

COST: This activity is \$5 for the general public and free to FOHXG members. Planting media and plants will be provided.

BRING: Each participant is asked to bring bits and pieces from cracked terracotta pots or new pots and are encouraged to bring any embellishment to be used to decorate their pot.
