Subject: Navy Groundwater Monitor Well Test Results – Second Quarter 2015

The subject test results show the second quarter total petroleum hydrocarbon (TPH) diesel levels are higher than the first quarter 2015 results for most of the monitor wells tested. The highest increase is at Red Hill monitor well 02 where the second quarter result is 5,200 parts per billion (ppb) compared to 1,100 ppb in the first quarter. Does the Department of Health know the reason for the increase? We would appreciate your comments on the results.
